- 1. CONTINUING A ("Temporary") TAX ON GASOLINE of 5 cents per gallon until August 1, 2013. West Virginia now has one of the highest in the region at 31-1/2 cents per gallon. Added to the Federal tax the total is 49-1/2 cents for West Virginia drivers. Hb2955 RC 92
- 2. IMPOSING A FEE FOR LICENSE OF PLUMBERS AND FIRE PROTECTION WORKERS OF UP TO \$75. HB2747, RC163
- 3. PROVIDE A \$1.5 MILLION TAX CREDIT FOR TOURISM DEVELOPMENT OR EXPANSION PROJECTS, and removing the cap so as to expand this government subsidized program. HB2309, RC191
- 4. MANDATING A CONTRIBUTION TO A CHARITABLE ENTITY VIA A \$20 REAL PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX with the proceeds funding the West Virginia Affordable Housing Trust Fund. SB335, RC254
- 5 IMPOSING A \$20 FEE ON ALL REAL EXTATE TRANSFERS. When added to the farmland protection fee it becomes an unfair increase in transfer costs. SB335, RC313
- 6 INCREASING THE COUNTIES HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX RATE ALLOWANCE TO 6 PERCENT. SB178, RC385
- 7 EXTENDING TAX INCREASE OF GASOLINE raising the state to 31.5 cents and hindering our ability to compete. HB2955, RC507
  - 8 BUDGET BILL OF \$3,775,938 WITH AN INCREASE AND PERTINENT FUNDS AT A GOOD LEVEL, TAXPAYERS SHOULD HAVE BEEN GIVEN SOME RELIEF. Passing budgets without study and some questioning, shows lack of concern for the Taxpayers of West Virginia. HB2007, RC550
