

2004 State Senate Family Values Questionnaire

1. Since abortions are presently legal, do you support requiring parental/guardians consent for minors to have abortions except in special cases as established by law)?
2. Do you support legislation stopping partial birth abortion?
3. Do you support legislation prohibiting state tax dollars being used to fund abortion?
4. Do you support casino gambling, including river-boat gambling in West Virginia?
5. Do you support the expansion of bingo, bingo casinos and raffles?
6. Do you support the expansion of video lottery/slot machines at the four dog and horse race tracks?
7. Do you support legalizing table game gambling (e.g. roulette, card games) in West Virginia?
8. Do you support the expansion of the West Virginia lottery?
9. Do you support a tax credit of \$1,000 per year per student to parents who send their children to a private school and \$500 for home schooling?
10. Do you support requiring the teaching in public schools the founding documents of the U.S. including the Declaration of Independence, the Constitutional and Bill of Rights, the Federalist Papers and other historical documents and writing, and their role in our history?
11. Do you support the requirement of timely parental notification so that children may "opt out" of any presentation of culturally offensive instruction or material on human sexuality and behavior to their children?
